

Adapt and be flexible: the mission continues

This research partnership between Action of Churches Together in Scotland (ACTS), Brendan Research, and the Scottish Church Leaders' Forum (SCLF) sought to understand how congregations across the nation had responded to the first lockdown, when change was most sudden. Over 350 leaders from 27 denominations from every part of Scotland took part in the research. The report demonstrates that the Scottish Church has been faithful to its calling, at a time of unprecedented disruption and suffering.
