Stage	Whole School Assembly for P1-7
Aim	<p>The aim of this event is to promote a key characteristic of spiritual intelligence: curiosity about what might be “out there” - enterprise is defined in the dictionary in terms of initiative, adventure, risk and exploration.</p> <p>‘Enterprise’ is one of the school’s key themes for this year, written in to the School Calendar from week 1.</p>
Objectives	<p>(1) Sensing mystery: experiences of awe, wonder and mystery about the natural world, human achievement and for some a divinity Sensing meaningfulness: the ability to make connections or to see potential patterns in one’s life which give it meaning Sensing ‘otherness’: the sentiment that humans are more than their physical elements</p> <p>(2) At the end of this event pupils should have a clear understanding of what ‘enterprise’ means, what an ‘enterprising’ attitude is, and should be thinking about adventures of their own in previously “unexplored” fields</p>

Is this part of a series?	This is a one-off TfR/RO event themed to the school calendar for the month
Introduction	The event will be introduced by the Senior Management highlighting the theme as 'Enterprise'
Stimulus/ stimuli	The stimulus, provided by the Chaplain, concerns a "misunderstanding" about 'Enterprise': the Chaplain "thinks" this is all about 'Star Trek' and the fictional space ship called 'Enterprise'. Stimulus comes from a number of props and objects related to Star Trek: a model of the star ship, a tricorder, a script
Guided Reflection	<p>(1) The model of the ship - shown while quoting the famous words "These are the voyages of the Star Ship Enterprise" highlighting that "enterprise" then is about exploration and adventure and risk, going places you've never been before, trying things you've never tried before, overcoming obstacles.</p> <p>(2) The original series 'Tricorder' - to help in the search for new life forms and aliens. The characters in Star Trek on a peaceful mission of exploration to make contact with new races and learn from them and build friendship</p> <p>(3) The Star Trek Script Book - the key to the success of 'Enterprise' is not in weapons or technology but in relationships and friendships and in communicating with others and learning from them</p> <p>Consider that perhaps the Chaplain has not been mistaken after all: Enterprise is about how we feel about exploring what's "out there" and how we cope with new situations, and it's about not shying away from adventure and risk</p>
